Do you have a favorite sports team? If so, lock that team in your mind for just a moment. Maybe it's a college team and you graduated from that school. If so, you would be a die-hard fan. What happens when your favorite team wins a big game? You respond like this: "WE DID IT! WE WON!" You may run around the living room high-fiving, chest-bumping, and doing a little jig.

Now my question is: What role did you play in this victory? Maybe you bought a jersey or a cap. Maybe you were at the game and you cheered them on to victory, but the truth is you didn't do anything that contributed to your team's success. Yet, you feel intense ownership and pride because this is YOUR team.

If you and I can feel this strongly about our favorite sports team, how much more intense should we feel about our church? We need to think of our church as "we." When God helps us to accomplish something great, we need to celebrate it and say, "We did it!" When you and I speak of our church we should say "we," for we are the church! Doing the work that God has called us to, while working together. You see, on God's team, we are all co-equals who simply fulfill different responsibilities.

So, what can we discover about God's team? First, we discover that even godly and competent leaders need encouragement. Even though many leaders look confident and secure on the outside, on the inside they can be discouraged and insecure. God's leaders are constantly under attack from Satan and need to be encouraged. Most of you know someone in a leadership role, take the time to encourage them today.

Secondly, we discover that to have a great team, you need to have a leader that shares ministry and trains others in ministry. One of my favorite quotes is from Admiral James B. Stockdale, "Leadership must be based on goodwill. It means obvious and wholehearted commitment to helping followers. What we need for leaders, are men and women of the heart who are so helpful that they, in effect, do away with the need of their jobs. But leaders like that are never out of a job, never out of followers. Strange as it sounds, great leaders gain authority by giving it away."

In your area of ministry, are you seeking to build a team? Are you taking the time to acknowledge and thank each person on your team? Are you training others to be successful in ministry? Start with your small group, Sunday school class, or the children's ministry or youth ministry, or the college group. Ask God to bring like-minded people to participate in that ministry. Pray for each other and encourage each other. If we will do this, then God will help our church to become a great team. Then as God helps us to accomplish something great, we can celebrate that together and say, "We did it!"




