Set My Heart Free

As we begin this New Year, we have so many reasons to be thankful. Looking back over the last year we see how God has faithfully opened doors for ministry. As those doors were opened, each of you have played a vital role in helping our church to continue to grow numerically and spiritually. But you have also made a greater impact in our community by touching lives. You saw the needs of the community and you were a bridge to the Gospel. God has set our hearts free and set our hearts on fire.

As I was praying about our theme for the coming year, God reminded me of this verse Ephesians 1:7, "We have been set free because of what Christ has done. Through his blood our sins have been forgiven. We have been set free because God's grace is so rich." I believe God wants to Set Us Free in 2023 and it's all because of what Christ has done. As Christians, we have freedom over sin and darkness when we follow Christ.

As I continued praying about the theme for the coming year, the Lord led me to Psalm 119. This is one of the most beautiful psalms in the Bible and it declares the greatness and glory of God's Word. Beginning in verse 25, the psalmist cries out to God to revive his soul, according to your Word. The psalmist felt as if he was near death and his life was in crisis. So, he seeks solace in God's Word. This too is where we should go when our lives are in turmoil because God uses His Word to bring revival to our lives. Revive us again, O Lord!

The psalmist continues as he asks the Lord to teach him His Word and give him understanding. James reminds us in the New Testament that, "if any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously." Too often we neglect to ask God for the things we need. We forget that He is God our provide and is ready to supply all of our needs. Jesus said, "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek and you will find, knock and the door will be opened to you."

Then the psalmist says to the Lord, "I have chosen the way of truth." When we are faced with temptation or a major decision in our life, it is always best to choose the way of truth. Charles Spurgeon said, "Men do not drop into the right way by chance; they must choose it, and continue to choose it, or they will soon wander from it." A life of truth is about our daily decisions. Every day our choices either turn us toward God or away from God.

Then in verse 32 the psalmist declares, "I run in the path of your commandments, for you have set my heart free." The psalmist understood that if he were to give himself entirely to God and to cling to His word, then he could trust God with complete confidence. His confidence is that God would set his heart free through His holy word and when Jesus sets you free, you are free indeed!

May God bless you and your family in the month of January and throughout the coming New Year. May God set your heart free in 2023.


