A Word From Our Pastor...

When we see God blessing our church with this current wave of momentum, we don't want it to stop. But as ministry gains speed, the demands on each of us will become greater. You might think that once you gain the momentum you've been working towards, it will finally free up time in your life. But it won't. In fact, your time will be even more constrained.

The temptation that we all face is to think; the great prayer time you had, last week. The eye-opening moment you had in Bible study, two months ago. Or the ministry success you had last year, will keep you riding that wave of momentum. But it doesn't work like that.

Your relationship with God is only as strong as your most recent encounter with Him. So, we have to make sure that our private devotion keeps pace with our ministry momentum. You must never get to the point where you're too busy ministering for God that you can't meet with God. No matter how great your ministry is going. You are never going to outgrow your need for prayer. You are never going to outgrow your need to study God's Word. And you are never going to outgrow your need for God.

God is the one who gave you the momentum in the first place. He is the one who will help you maintain that momentum. And God is the one who will sustain you through that momentum, as the demands on your life become greater. Even Jesus felt the need to go off by Himself and spend time in prayer as people began gathering around Him. Personally, I'm not going to be the one who says I need less private time with God than Jesus needed.

Bryant H. McGill said, "Enthusiasm is the energy and force that builds literal momentum of the human soul and mind." Enthusiasm is contagious and it gives us the energy we need to get the momentum going. Momentum is important to understand and recognize when you are moving towards your goals. When you start to feel the momentum, the key is to keep it going and ride that wave of momentum. The most important aspect of creating momentum is taking clear decisive action.

Creating momentum in your life requires increasing the things that move you forward and decreasing those that hold you back. Sounds easy; but I know, just like you do, that living the life that God desires is not always easy to achieve. You will have roadblocks to overcome. But by creating momentum, you can move past those obstacles and move toward the life God has for you. How do you get the momentum you need for change that lasts, that inspires, and that infuses every day with purpose? You begin with prayer. Prayer is God's idea. Spend time every day in prayer. And embrace the presence of the Holy Spirit in your life. What did Jesus say when he went to the Father? He said he would send the Holy Spirit. And what would the Holy Spirit do? Give us power from on high.

These two great truths stand out when we see God blessing us with a wave of momentum. Where there is much prayer, there is the vivid presence of the Holy Spirit. This dynamic relationship produces that which is beyond us.

In describing the church without dependence on the Holy Spirit, Samuel Chadwick said, "the church fails at the point of self-confidence." What is true of the church is true of us an individuals. We don't do "greater things than these" because we don't believe we can.

So how do we continue to ride this current wave of momentum that God has brought us? Pray that God will open our eyes to what he is doing. That he will empower our prayers to do His will. And increase our faith to believe that we can do even greater things than these. "For nothing is impossible with God."

May God bless you and your family during the month of June, as we ride this wave of momentum together.

Moving Forward...

Here is our new logo and the importance of each detail. Thank you Andrea and Jamie for working so hard on making just the right logo for us!

<u>From the design team</u>: After much prayerful discernment and talking to Matt and other members about the heart of, and vision for, the church moving into this new season, this logo design is the outpouring of those events, discussions, and God's guidance.

The goal: To create a logo that honors our past, looks to where God is guiding us forward, and conveys the heart and vision of our church to all who see it. (To love everyone inside and outside of our congregation as Christ does)

- -The cross in the middle of the heart is pulled from our old logo to honor our church's history
- -The blue ring, broken up into 3 circular parts, represents the Godhead Trinity (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) while also making a nod to the three rings in the Global Methodist Church logo referencing the Trinity as well
- -The blue of the circle is official Global Methodist Church blue to represent where God is leading us currently



-The hand at the innermost part of the blue circle and close to the heart, in combination with the encircling nature of the design element it is attached to is meant to convey to those looking at it as an embrace. When this idea is linked with the cross inside the heart it surrounds, the goal is for those who see it to understand our church's heart, and as a result our vision and atmosphere is to embrace and love everyone as Christ does.
