#### Strive to be First

I still remember fondly, Christmas mornings as a child. Mom and dad would tuck us in our beds and it was a race to see who could fall asleep first. When the morning came, it was another race to see who could get to their presents first. My brothers and I have been competitive ever since.

An unknown author once said, "Strive to be first" and this is exactly what our society teaches us today. We want to be first in line, first to have the latest toys and gadgets. First, to experience the latest fads and first to accomplish the tasks that will take us to the top. The author of this statement further added how we should be..."First to nod, first to smile, first to compliment and first to forgive."
