A Note from our Pastor...

In Pursuit of God

April is the National Month of Hope. Established in 2016 by a non-profit organization called Mothers in Crisis in Tallahassee, Florida. The idea behind it was simply to counteract the difficulties that life brings by dedicating this month and encouraging people to spread hope around the neighborhoods, and communities, and all around the world.

As we begin this second quarter of the year, I am still super excited about what God can and will accomplish through us this year. As I have prayed about the possibilities and talked with different people about how we can accomplish greater things for the glory of God, the number seven keeps coming up.

In the Bible, the number seven is found from beginning to end and has deep spiritual significance. In the Hebrew language seven is the number of completeness and perfection (both physical and spiritual). It derives much of its meaning from being tied directly to God's creation of all things which was completed after seven days (the last day being a day of rest). Our world still operates under this God established system.

Another interesting occurrence is the seventh year or Sabbatical year, during which the fields were to be left fallow and debts released (in Hebrew it is called Shemittah). After a cycle of seven Shemittah's or 49 years, the next year is the year of Jubilee.

As well as giving the people an opportunity to put their faith in God and see it fulfilled, the year-long abstention from farming also allowed them to collectively take a break and focus on higher, more spiritual pursuits. Even today, while the vast majority of Jews and Christians are not involved in farming, the lessons of the Shemittah are still relevant.

These lessons can help us get headed in the direction of spiritual maturity and establish habits that promote spiritual growth: (a) Focus more on our spiritual mission in life, and a little less on our material pursuits. (b) Focus more on why we are needed, and less on what we need. (c) And focus more on our faith in God, and less on our faith in our own talents and abilities.

My hope for each of us this year is that we collectively concentrate more of our attention on the pursuit of God. As I shared recently, remember to dream and imagine what God can do through you for His glory in 2024.

May God continue to bless you and your family during the month of April (the month of hope) and throughout the coming year.
