

GENERAL RULES

- Show respect for volunteers, other people, their property, and the facilities.
- Listen when others are talking and to the volunteers at all times
- Clean up after yourself
- Don't physically, mentally, or emotionally harm yourself or others
- No cursing, swearing, put-downs, or bullying
- Be where your supposed to be not where your not
- And most importantly encourage, comfort, and lift one another up while showing Christ's love to everyone we encounter

DETAILED RULES

- All participants must respect others physical boundaries. No inappropriate physical behavior (i.e. rough housing/carrying others, bullying, sitting/laying on others, holding hands — unless entire group is holding hands for a game or group prayer —, physical intimacy/PDA, sexual harassment, etc.).
- No verbal/social/text bullying, gossip/spreading rumors, harassment, or continued mean/ discouraging/inappropriate/trash talk.
- Be responsible for your behavior by respecting the physical, mental and emotional health and safety of both others and yourself.
- Be considerate, respectful, and encouraging of other participants, volunteers, and leaders.
- Students are not allowed to go outside of the church/venue/meeting area without adult supervision or permission from an adult leader.
- You must participate in all activities, including meals, hangouts, and activities that you are present for.
- No illegal drugs/controlled substances, alcohol, tobacco products, CBD, vaping devices, dangerous materials, weapons (knives, guns, blow guns, brass knuckles, slingshots, etc.), or explosives may be brought to ministry gatherings.

- · No smoking, vaping, drinking, or illegal drug use.
- Be respectful of the meeting place and use property and equipment in considerate and appropriate ways.
- No one is allowed to attend trips, or ride the bus without a signed Permission Form and Group Rules from parent/guardian and participant.

DRESS CODE

- No sleeveless shirts
- No sagging pants. Pants must remain at waistline
- No short shorts or mini skirts
- No tight clothes
- No crop tops
- Leggings can be worn with shirts that come to mid-thigh
- No jeans with holes above the knee (unless paired with leggings underneath)

VISION & PROCEDURES

If you see someone breaking one of these rules, come to an adult to address the issue instead of talking about it openly with other students. Our goal in all of these rules is to create a welcoming environment, grow closer as a student ministry fam, and most importantly grow more into the loving likeness of Christ (not to shame others or make them feel unwelcome).

Breaking of any of these rules may result in these steps:

- 1. The student will be asked by an adult leader to correct the behavior.
- 2. The student minister will talk with the student to discuss the problem behavior.
- 3. Parents will be notified of discipline or behavior problems.
- 4. The student will not be allowed to attend ministry event(s) for a determined amount of time based on the severity of rule(s) broken.
- 5. A talk with both the church pastor and student minister to determine next steps.

Any questions about violations and enforcement will be decided by the student minister.
