Dream Bigger Dreams

In the coming year, our challenge is to Dream Bigger Dreams. God has a dream for your life and a dream for the life of our church. Dreams matter to God. Too often, we let the limitations of our circumstances or the expectations of our world shrink our dreams. God wants to demonstrate His nature, His strength, and His kindness to a watching world. God doesn't just call you to work for Him; He calls you to work with Him!

So, what are we to do? When we reach the stage of hearing from God and we know what He is saying. God has given us a dream but it is God-sized? We say, "I can't do it myself." And God says, "Exactly!" When our thinking is too small, we have to expand our paradigm. Move outside of our comfort zone (believe and obey) and God will transform our dreams into reality. Most Christians are just one prayer away from God doing a mighty work in them and through them. What has God laid on your heart? Does it seem impossible? When the task seems impossible, we have to remember that all things are possible with God.

May God bless you and your family in the month of January, as you endeavor to dream bigger dreams in 2026.






